Dear Parents and Guardians,

In light of the return stage 4 restrictions over the next 3 school days, Northside Christian College will move to a short term Prep to Year 12 Remote Learning Program.

The introduction of stage 4 restrictions for this short period of time once again means that only a very small scale supervision program will be running onsite at the College. An updated Remote Learning guide for the next few days is also attached along with this letter.

For Monday 15th February to Wednesday 17th February, the onsite supervision program for P-10 is only available to students in the following categories:

- children whose parents **both** work in one of the defined essential continuing industries and can not work from home
- vulnerable children including:
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm
 - children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).
- children with a disability who also fit one of the above two categories, or
- where the family is experiencing severe stress.

Please contact the College office if you believe that your home situation may qualify for onsite supervision for your children according to the above criteria.
